

# Theory of Change

## Problem

**Exposure of violence in the context of family / neighbourhood:** (leading to desensitized, learned behaviour)

**Traumatic adverse childhood experiences:** (Chaotic family setting, co-morbidities)

**Perception of unattainable status through legitimate means:** (Due to unmet needs, low aspiration, humiliation, lack of respect, lack of opportunity)

**Self-protection:** (Danger is routine, inability to trust the authorities to protect you, violent reputation is a deterrent)

**Situational Risk:** (Night-time economy & increased opportunity for recreational substance use, risks of coastal region e.g. isolation, reduced opportunities & financial freedoms, generational permanence, population density, and resultant increases in crime)



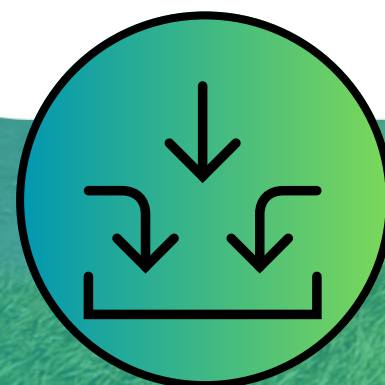
## Inputs

**Funding, resources & capacity:** (Home Office & Match)

**Data:** (Data sharing, capturing local/cultural/community insight, SNA)

**External Collaboration:** (University, partners, YEF, youth voice, steering boards, evidence-based interventions)

**Partnership:** (Good Governance, collaboration, co-production, building of trust, regional credibility)

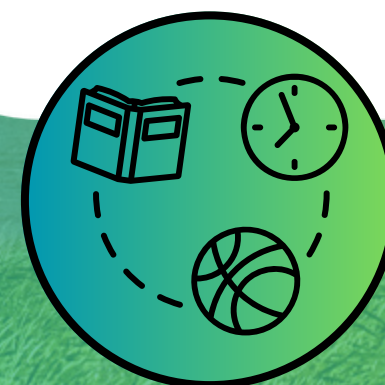


## Activities

**Continuous improvement:** (Data sharing, improve data literacy, ongoing evaluation, stakeholder co-production, youth voice)

**Delivering interventions:** (Identifying cohort & delivering appropriate and accessible interventions)

**Operational oversight:** (Systems leadership, relationship management, strategic consultation, communications, Trauma Informed approach)



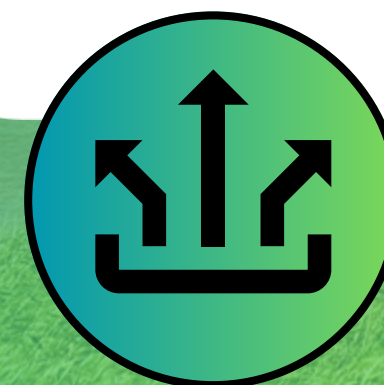
## Outputs

**Shared Vision & Ownership:** (Interagency partnerships, shared understanding, enhanced co-operation)

**Introduction of new approaches/mechanisms to violence reduction:** (Early intervention, Trauma Informed approaches, sports programs)

**Target co-hort engaged with interventions**

**Improve data quality & sharing across all partners**



## Outcomes

**'Bright Futures':** (Young people feel valued)

**Safer Communities:** (reduction in violence & associated costs)

**Communities feel safer:** (Night-time economy, improvements to physical environment, improved place & sense of place)

**Sustainable partnership:** (evidence-led decision making, response strategy, committed partnership)

**Combined outcome:** ('Safer Childhoods' in Humberside, emotionally and physically)
